

TEN WEEKS IN GENESIS – WEEK 1

<p><u>Monday 2nd May – Genesis 1.1-25</u> As God's creation is unveiled, one phrase recurs: "It was good". In what ways should we, as Christians, honour the sky, the sea, the earth, vegetation; animals and the like</p>	
<p><u>Tuesday 3rd May – Genesis 1.26-2.25</u> God's creation finds its pinnacle in humanity which is "very good" (1.31) God placed people in community to help one another (2.18) What does it mean for you to live in a community?</p>	
<p><u>Wednesday 4th May – Genesis 3.1-24</u> Verses 1-6 describe how Adam and Eve were tempted. What was their motivation in sinning? Verses 7-20 show the consequences of their sin. What makes you hide?</p>	
<p><u>Thursday 5th May – Genesis 4.1-16</u> Man begins life away from God's presence. Mutuality soon gives way to self-centredness. What is God's reaction to our self-centredness?</p>	
<p><u>Friday 6th May – Genesis 4.17-5.32</u> Cain and his descendants continued a self-centred life (4.17-24) But, as men called upon Him (4.26) God established an alternative line. The new pinnacle was Enoch, who walked with God (5.23). Do you?</p>	
<p><u>Saturday 7th May – Genesis 6:1-22</u> A righteous man living in a corrupt and violent world. Sound familiar? What can we learn from Noah's lifestyle?</p>	
<p><u>Sunday 8th May – Genesis 7.1 – 8.22</u> A familiar story of destruction ends with a new beginning. What encouragement do you find from God's covenant in 8.22?</p>
