

TEN WEEKS IN GENESIS – WEEK 9

<p><u>Monday 27th June – Genesis 38.1-30</u> It is easy to see many wrong things in this episode. But can you see anything good? How do we view people today whose lifestyles don't measure up to God's standards – and that includes us!</p>	
<p><u>Tuesday 28th June – Genesis 39.1-23</u> The Lord was with Joseph (see verses 2, 3,5,21,& 23) Why do you think that was? How do we respond to adverse conditions?</p>	
<p><u>Wednesday 29th June – Genesis 40.1 -23</u> Notice the timescales involved at 40.1; 40.4; and 41.1. Which fruits of the Spirit (see Galatians 5.22-23) do you see revealed in Joseph's life? Ask God to make these fruit more visible in your life today.</p>	
<p><u>Thursday 30th June – Genesis 41.1-43</u> What might have given Joseph the confidence to speak so boldly to Pharaoh? How do you think Joseph felt at Pharaoh's response in verses 41 – 43?</p>	
<p><u>Friday 1st July – Genesis 41.44 – 42.2</u> As news of sufficiency spread during the famine, so people came searching. Pray that the sufficiency of the gospel might be evident in this land where there is much spiritual drought – and that people might see what God offers through us.</p>	
<p><u>Saturday 2nd July – Genesis 42.3-38</u> Verse 22 shows that despite the passing of the years, the brothers' sense of guilt at their attitude to Joseph was still eating away inside them. Thank God that, through Jesus, our guilty consciences can be cleansed (see Hebrews 10.22)</p>	
<p><u>Sunday 3rd July – Genesis 43.1 – 44.13</u> Imagine how Jacob felt when he allowed his youngest son to travel to Egypt. And imagine how God felt when He allowed His only Son to approach the cross.</p>
